

# TOLERANCE AND EFFICACY OF A NEW EMOLLIENT PLUS CONTAINING AQUAPHILUS DOLOMIAE AND DEXTRAN SODIUM SULFATE EXTRACTS IN IMPROVING LONG-TERM ATOPIC SKIN CONDITION

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## INTRODUCTION

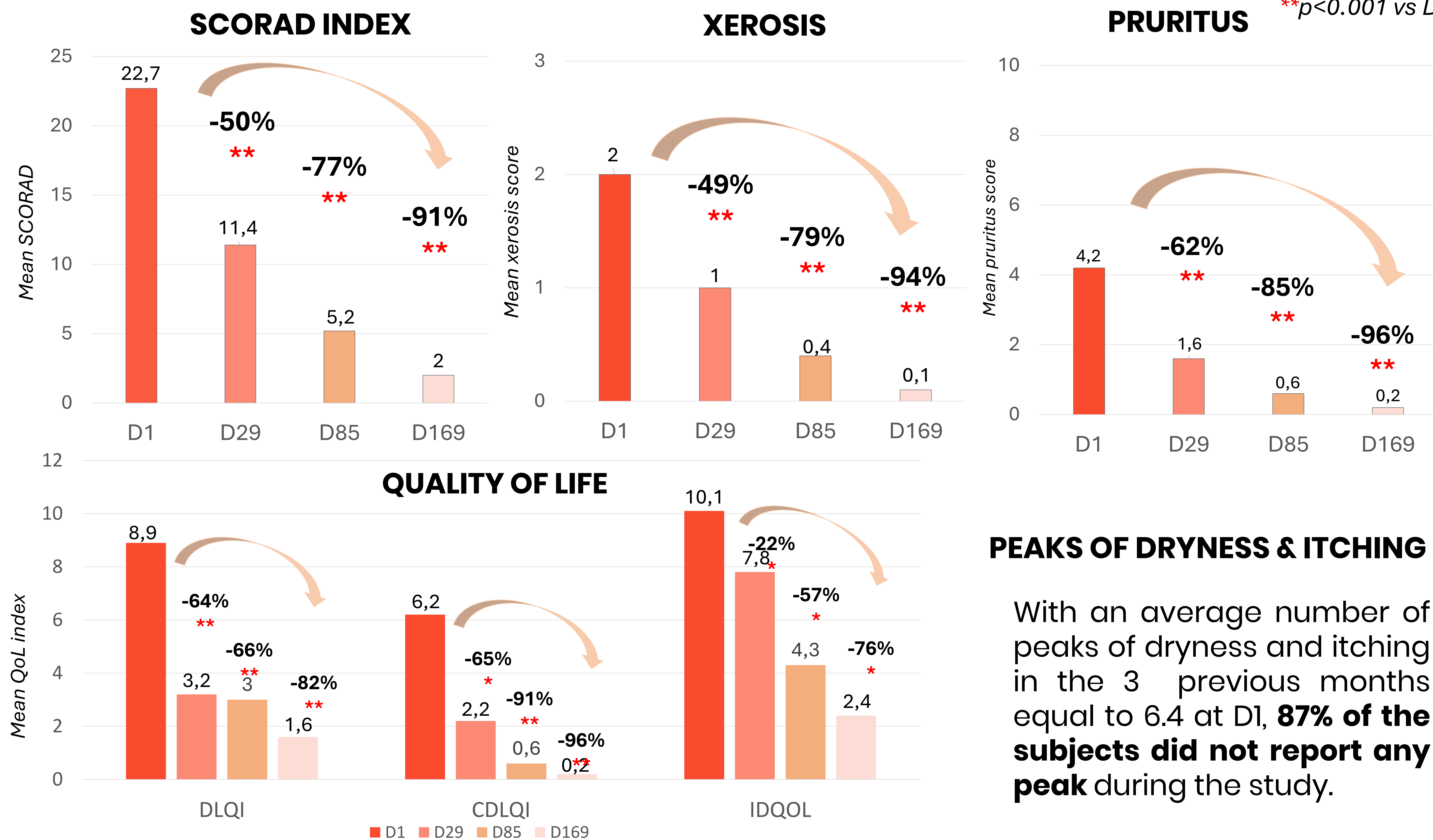
- Emollients are considered as the first-line therapy of atopic dermatitis (AD) management. Their prolonged application has been shown to improve skin condition, patient's quality of life and space-out flare-ups. These products must be safe, effective and suitable for infants, children and adults.
- This study aimed to assess the tolerance and efficacy of a new emollient Plus (balm) containing *Aquaphilus Dolomia*e and *Dextran sodium sulfate* extracts, intended to improve long-term atopic skin condition.

## EFFICACY

Significant improvement of clinical parameters and quality of life at each timepoint :

\* $p < 0.05$  vs D1

\*\* $p < 0.001$  vs D1



## PEAKS OF DRYNESS & ITCHING

With an average number of peaks of dryness and itching in the 3 previous months equal to 6.4 at D1, **87% of the subjects did not report any peak** during the study.

## TOLERANCE

Tolerance was deemed **very good** by both dermatologist and pediatrician

## ACCEPTABILITY

**97%** of the subjects declared their skin **comfortable & soothed**

## CONCLUSION

The efficacy results of this 6-month long clinical study demonstrate the benefits of this new emollient Plus in improving the long-term management of atopic skin condition. Moreover, its very good tolerance and acceptability by the patients could help to ensure long-term compliance.
